

Ix Art Park welcomes 50+ vendors to the Charlottesville Arts Festival in May

(Charlottesville, Virginia - May 9, 2023) From Saturday, May 27 through Sunday, May 28, the Ix Art Park Foundation in downtown Charlottesville will host 50+ art vendors from across the East Coast for the Charlottesville Arts Festival. The festival is a two-day celebration of creativity, diversity and community providing locals and visitors of all ages a chance to immerse themselves in arts of all genres. Vendor booths will feature paintings, drawings, photography, sculptures, ceramics, jewelry, glass, fiber arts and more.

The Charlottesville Arts Festival, presented in partnership with Virginia Tourism Corporation, Virginia Commission for the Arts, Barton Marlow, Blue Ridge Beverage, Crutchfield, and Ting will be open from 3pm to 8pm on Saturday, May 27, and from 10am to 6pm on Sunday, May 28. Tickets are \$7 per day or visitors can purchase a \$12 pass for both days. Additionally, patrons can enjoy Virginia's first immersive art museum at the discounted rate of \$5. Children 12 years old and under are welcome to both the festival and The Looking Glass for free. Tickets are available at ixartpark.org/arts-festival.
